### Voter Information

- ❖ **The Annual School Election and Budget Vote is Wednesday, April 27, 2011.**
- ❖ To vote in the Annual School Election on Wednesday, April 27, new voter registration applications must be received in the office of the Bergen County Superintendent of Elections by April 6, 2011. The **ballot must be postmarked on or before April 6.**
- ❖ To vote by mail, **ballots must be received in the office of the Bergen County Superintendent of Elections on or before April 26. If applying for a mail-in ballot please allow seven (7) days to receive the ballot in the mail.**
  
- ✓ WHO MAY REGISTER TO VOTE IN BERGEN COUNTY?
  - You are eligible to register to vote if:
    1. You are a citizen of the United States
    2. You are a Bergen County resident 30 days before the election
    3. You are a resident of the election district in which you live
    4. You will be 18 years of age on or before the next election
    5. You are not incarcerated, on parole, or on probation due to a conviction for an indictable offense under any federal or state laws.

  - Registration forms must be received in the office of the Bergen County Superintendent of Elections at least 21 days prior to the election in which you wish to vote.
